Sudoku

The classic Sudoku game involves a grid of 81 squares. The grid is divided into nine blocks, each containing nine squares. The rules of the game are simple: each of the nine blocks has to contain all the numbers 1-9 within its squares. Each number can only appear once in a row, column or box.

The difficulty lies in that each vertical nine-square column, or horizontal nine-square line across, within the larger square, must also contain the numbers 1-9, without repetition or omission.

Entry Doors See Sales Resurgence

According to industry insiders, sales of entry doors have experienced a big turnaround recently. Volume is up 20-30% this year over last, and double digit growth is expected into the foreseeable future. Steel and fiberglass products, which now account for approximately 80% of the overall market, are seeing the largest growth, with wood doors, which comprise the remaining 20%, close behind. The majority of door sales (60%) are now designated for the replacement market while 40% find their way into new home construction.

Whereas simulated oak fiberglass doors were popular in the past, homeowners are now gravitating toward fir and mahogany looks. Craftsman and Mission styles are particularly popular. Another trend is a return to a simple, modern look with straight lines and fewer panels. According to Derek Fielding of Therma-Tru doors, "There has been a resurgence of the mid-20th century look: a modern, contemporary look with no angles." Larger doors are now in vogue, with more glass — this dovetails with the trend of letting in light and opening up a home to the outdoors (people concerned about privacy choose from a variety of obscure glass patterns). Recognizing the hectic pace of life and time demands on people today, many manufacturers and door shops now offer prefinished products. This makes for minimal disruption of homeowners' schedules — an entry door can be completely installed in one day.

- Recycle used ribbons, bows and decorative wrappings. Store used paper and accessories in a convenient place for the next birthday or holiday occasion.
- Try alternatives to store-bought wrapping paper. Leftover fabric, lightweight wallpaper, colorful scarves and even the Sunday comics work just as well.
- Buy a live holiday tree. The tree will survive inside for about a week with ample watering and somewhat cool air temperatures. When you're ready, transplant it outside to a spot you have already prepared, or donate it to a school or community center. If you buy a cut tree rather than a live one, recycle it.
- Purchase greeting cards from a non-profit organization. In many cases, a part of the purchase price can be deducted as a contribution to the organization.
- Entertain efficiently. Replace throwaway plates, cups, silverware and napkins with durable goods you can use season after season.
- Reuse cookie tins, baskets and festive food containers. Refill these next year and give them as gifts.
